

## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

### 5.1 Conclusion

After the researcher analyzed about students found compound words and its translating in narrative text. The researcher made some conclusions such as following below:

1. It can be concluded that the researcher found that the students can understand about compound words in narrative text. The researcher found same compound words in each student in "Snow Maiden" such as "*got married, long time, came true, snow mountain, snow girl, come in, jump on and old woman*" and same compound words incorrectly "*lived happily, friend love, cried happing, useless, poor them, a new snow maiden, girl alone and started making*". The reseacher found same compound words in

each student in “Dragon of Kinabalu” such as *“beautiful pearl, famous mountain, fake pearl, large kite, flew up, the mountain-top, big party, tall tree, real pearl and clever idea”* and some compound words incorrectly *“the top of Mount Kinabalu, the emperor of China and their journey”*.

2. It can be concluded that the researcher found that the students seldom use three types of translating strategies namely word for word translation, faithful translation and free translation. In this case, the researcher found that the students often translated compound words by using word for word translation.

## **5.2 Suggestion**

Based on the result of study, the researcher made some suggestion, they are:

1. For the Teacher

The researcher hopes, the teacher can teach about compound words concept and translating strategies to the students deeply in the classroom. In fact, it is very important to understand about words and its form, because its presence can be a major influence in a language.

2. For the Students

The researcher hopes, the students who can interested about compound words deeply in the classroom and add their knowledge about translating strategies.

3. For the Reader

The results of this study can give more knowledge to the reader more information about compound words and translating strategies more deeply.

In addition, this study is also expected to become a further reference and the reader interested to learn about morphology study analysis.
